the community work and giving by Mayor Rehl.

David Brockman asked if the City has acquired any other proposals to replace the sprinkler meters. Mr. Brockman said he used the sprinkler meter for keeping up his yard

and would like to continue to do so.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. <u>Discussion and/or Motion Items:</u>

a. Commissioner Hedrington made a motion to approve Resolution <u>6297</u> authorizing the Mayor to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with the HIDTA Statewide

- Deconfliction System. Commissioner Fitzgerald second the motion. Roll call vote showed 4 ayes and 1 absent by Commissioner Adleman.
- b. Commissioner Morse made a motion to approve Resolution 6298 authorizing the Mayor to execute a Sergeant's Agreement. Commissioner Hedrington second the motion. Attorney Sosnowski said the agreement governs the terms and conditions of employment, and provides a step salary for sergeants. The step salary provides a graduated scale depending on the number of years of service. Attorney Sosnowski said the agreement also governs shift selection. The salary would be 9% above the highest paid Patrol Officer. Commissioners Hedrington and Fitzgerald voiced concern over the salary schedule increasing in too short of a time frame. Commissioner Hedrington made a motion to layover the Resolution. Commissioner Fitzgerald second the motion. Voice vote carried the motion.
- c. Commissioner Fitzgerald made a motion to approve Resolution <u>6299</u> authorizing the Thirty-sixth IEPA Loan Disbursement in the amount of \$223,634.81. Commissioner Hedrington second the motion. Roll call vote showed 4 ayes and 1 absent by Commissioner Adleman.
