### <u>South Beloit, Illinois</u> <u>Attachments to IEPA Annual Report, NPDES Permit for Storm Water Discharge from MS4's</u> (2019-2020) - Year #6

Based on the comments provided in the 2019 MS4 inspection by the IEPA the City updated their Stormwater Management Plan, evaluated the City for potential environmental justice areas (and located none), and created documentation forms for improved record keeping for stormwater discharge and outfall inspections. The City had planned to complete their annual public meeting to describe the MS4 program, but due to difficulties from the COVID-19 pandemic this was placed on hold and will resume later in 2020.

- A. No changes to the best management practices at this time.
- B. 1. <u>Public Education and Outreach</u>
  - The City has several links on their website that are updated as necessary.
  - The City reviews and updates Educational brochures, which are available at City Hall for the public.
  - Several site plans have been submitted to the City and reviewed by the City Engineer. The City informs developers about best management practices (BMP's) for site plans which are received.
  - 2. <u>Public Participation/Involvement</u>
    - Storm Drain Marking The City of South Beloit paints storm inlets to clearly demarcate that they drain to water ways.
    - The City touched up 68 drains in the 2019-2020 time period.
    - The City has a medication drop off located at the police station. They average between five and six pounds of medication collected per month.
    - The City encourages residents to volunteer for Keep Northern Illinois Beautiful *Great American Cleanup Day*.
    - The City continues to make the public aware of any upcoming events where public participation is needed.

## 3. Illicit Discharge Detection & Elimination

- The City updates storm sewer maps as necessary.
- The City sends updates to the WinGIS map program.
- The City checks for illegal dumping and illegal discharge during dry periods.
- The City completed the Illicit Discharge Monitoring in August 2019.
- The City requires their employees to attend training sessions.
- The City's Ordinances are reviewed annually and are updated as needed.
- The City continues to operate their Illicit Discharge Detection & Elimination (IDDE) Plan while making adjustments along the way.
- 4. <u>Construction Site Runoff Control</u>
  - The City reviews the Erosion & Sediment Control Ordinance.
  - The City maintains an Erosion Control Inspection Log and other necessary paperwork onsite with NPDES permits.
  - The City encourages green infrastructure.
  - The City has a contract with the City Engineer for reviewing site plans and periodic site inspections.
  - The City continues to update and revise procedures.

- The City works with developers and regional inspectors to ensure BMP's are being implemented.
- The City took action multiple times in developer driven projects to shut down the project due to lack of proper BMP implementation.

# 5. <u>Post-Construction Runoff Control</u>

- City staff reviews the Storm Water Management Plan annually.
- City staff sweeps all streets within the City boundaries each spring and fall and sweeps during the summer, as necessary.
- Street sweeping prevented 222 cubic yards of debris and sediment from reaching water ways.
- City staff repaired a total of 19 inlets.
- City staff meets monthly for discussion, planning, and training/education.
- City staff attended the Soil Erosion and Sediment Control Workshop hosted by the Dekalb County Soil and Water Conservation Districts on April 4, 2019.
- City Engineer continues to review any new proposed development over one acre or a smaller than one acre parcel within a larger development to oversee and ensure compliance with MS4 BMP's and address any issues with compliance.
- City staff and City Engineer review site plans and conduct surprise site inspections, ensuring proper paperwork has been obtained for permits.

## 6. <u>Pollution Prevention/Good Housekeeping</u>

- Continued employee training monthly.
- Continued employee training by City Staff for IEPA MS4 classes.
- Continue to offer new and various trainings for hourly staff.
- The City adopted Winnebago County's Hazardous Waste Spill Response and Prevention Program as their ordinance. They use Winnebago County's HAZMAT team for emergency situations.
- The City Fire Department receives paperwork annually for businesses that handle large amounts of hazardous waste.
- All City storm sewer inlets are cleaned off after major rain events.
- The City keeps a large supply of oil dry for any spills on City roadways.
- The majority of City trucks have spill kits to contain small spills.
- C. No monitoring data collected at this time.
- D. The City will continue to enforce BMP's for site developments. The City will attempt to meet the measurable goals outlined in its permit. The City shall specifically review its sewer outfall inventory and update it as needed. The City will continue to review any site developments and assist the permit holders in complying with their NPDES permit requirements.
- E. The City works with the Winnebago County HAZMAT team during hazardous waste spills.

  - 2019 Oak Grove and Doner Drive Roadway Reconstruction

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
