REGULATIONS

1. Boating is open to South Beloit residents along with the general public
2. Occupants must be at least 18 yrs or older. Anyone under 18 yrs, of age must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian.
3. A yearly permit must be obtained at the City Clerk's office prior to launching any boat, unless a daily launch permit is purchased at the park.
4. The boating sticker must be placed on the left front side of the tongue of the boat trailer
5. Non trailered boats must have the sticker on the front left side of the boat
6. Maximum boat length allowed is 17 ft long.
7. Electric trolling motors up to 55 Lb thrust will be allowed. No other motors are permitted, including but not limited to gas powered or electric powered motors or engines.
8. Boating is allowed from dawn to dusk. Lake Victoria is open April 15th to November 30th.
9. Boat trailers must be parked in designated parking areas located in the park.
10. All occupants in the boat are required to wear a life jacket.
11. No person shall possess alcoholic beverages while in the boat or on park grounds.
12. Illinois fishing license is required for anyone 16 yrs and older.
13. Wading or Swimming is prohibited
14. Fishing with minnows or leaches is not permitted
15. Any other exceptions must be approved by the South Beloit City Council

Boat: Shall mean any vessel or instrument designed to carry persons upon water: "rowboat, fishing boats, canoes, kayaks, paddle boats, rafts, and sail boats."

Penalties for violation of lake rules or ordinances 1606, 2/05/01:

- 1st offense: \$75 & boat permit revoked for one year
- 2nd offense \$150 & boat permit revoked for one year
- 3rd offense \$500 & boat permit revoked for two years
